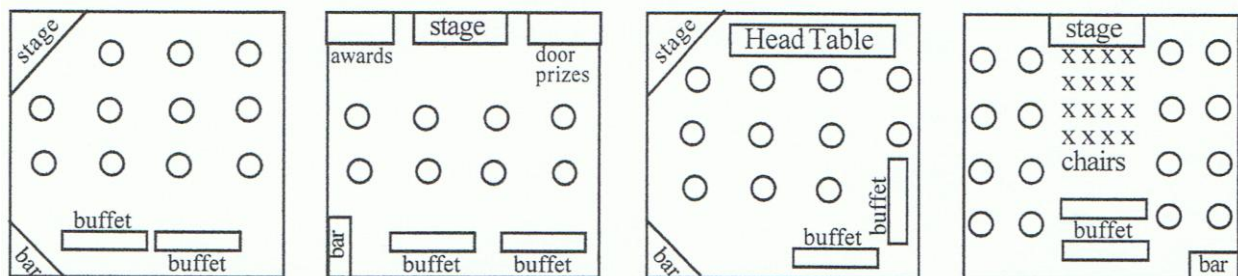
### Room setup information

Ventriloquism and magic are visual arts. It is critical that the audience be able to see and hear the performer. At a minimum, the audience should be able to see the performance area from waist height and above. **Seating should be in front of the performance area, not to the sides and never behind.** If there is a dance floor in front of the performance space, make arrangements to place chairs on the dance floor during the performance and remove them later for dancing.

In addition to good sight lines, it is important to provide a safe and convenient path for audience volunteers to come on stage. If the stage is a raised platform, please provide a good set of stairs in the front or to the side.

The stage area should be at least 8' deep by 12' wide.

Below are some suggested room layouts for a successful event. Please work with the facility to ensure these guidelines are taken into account.



One final note – please consider sight lines when planning decorations to ensure they do not interfere with your guests' ability to enjoy the performance. Balloons on tables are particularly troublesome.
